

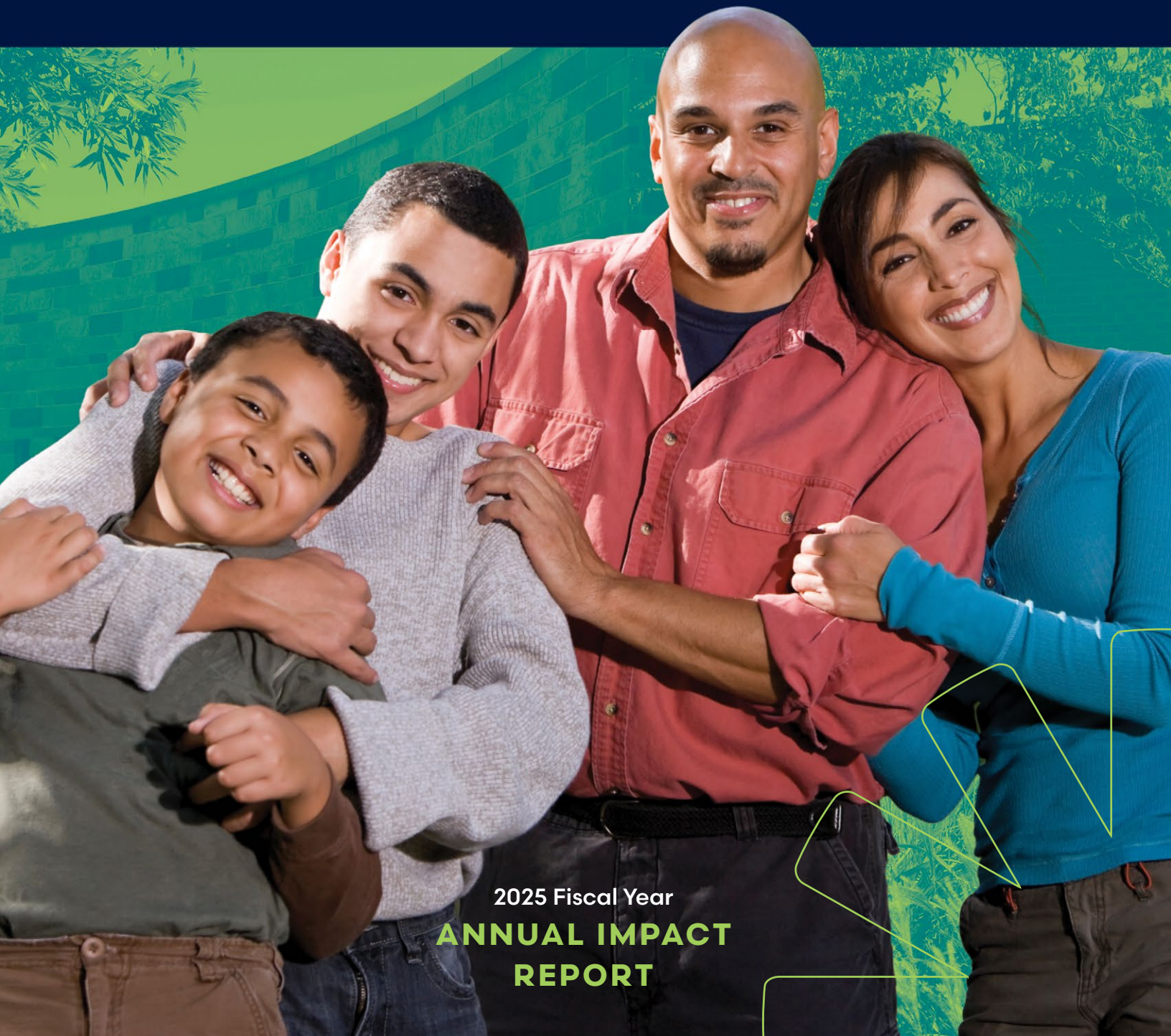

At Everstand, behavioral health remains a key focus for youth, families, and care teams. We continue to provide compassionate, evidence-based care to address a range of common conditions, including:

- Trauma and Stressor-Related Disorders
- Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)
- Disruptive Mood Dysregulation
- Depression
- Anxiety
- Autism Spectrum Disorder

By working closely with families and care professionals, Everstand helps ensure every child receives the support they need to grow, heal, and thrive.

Strawbridge School: Unlocking Potential, Transforming Lives



At Strawbridge School, we believe every child deserves a place to be seen, supported, and celebrated for who they are. More than a school, Strawbridge is a therapeutic environment where potential is unlocked and **hope is restored**. Students come to us after facing tremendous challenges in academic settings where their needs have gone unmet, but here they find a community that nurtures their academic, social, and emotional growth—and believes deeply in their ability to thrive.

MEETING STUDENTS WHERE THEY ARE

What makes Strawbridge unique within Everstand’s continuum of programming is our whole-child, trauma-informed approach. Every student is enrolled in a specialized education setting, and most arrive after exhausting the options available in traditional school settings. Many carry the weight of school-based trauma or instability at home.

Before we ask students to engage in academics, we first ensure their well-being. We **meet them at the door**—addressing immediate and essential needs such as food, clothing, and therapeutic support. By first meeting their essential needs and making the effort to understand behaviors as communication rather than defiance, we create the foundation for learning. Through Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS), incentive calendars, and individualized care plans, we build trust and stability so that structure, safety, and belonging naturally follow—allowing healing and learning to happen side by side.

STUDENTS AND FAMILIES IN TRANSFORMATION

Our students are remarkable in their resilience. Many arrive operating in “survival mode,” unsure how to trust or even envision a hopeful future for themselves. Slowly, the walls built from anger and shame begin to come down. Students start to believe they are worthy of love, safety, and success. Families, too, feel this transformation, as Strawbridge becomes a partner in helping them navigate daily challenges and find stability.

We’ve witnessed students once defined by aggression build lasting, trusting relationships with staff. Others who required one-on-one support have grown into greater independence. Many learn to self-advocate, replacing maladaptive behaviors with healthier ways of expressing their needs. Each milestone—whether a quiet moment of progress or walking across the graduation stage—is celebrated as a triumph of courage and growth.

PREPARING FOR THE FUTURE

Strawbridge is about more than academics—it’s about preparing students for life. Therapeutic services are embedded in every student’s Individualized Education Plan (IEP), and our programming extends to life skills, vocational training, and career exploration. Students tour trade schools and community colleges, explore job readiness and financial literacy, and build coping and communication skills that will serve them far beyond the classroom.

Through daily practice of coping strategies, emotional regulation, and social-emotional learning, students develop the tools they’ll rely on long after graduation—skills that help them navigate challenges, build healthy relationships, and approach adulthood with confidence and resilience.

WHY STRAWBRIDGE MATTERS

Without Strawbridge, students facing complex learning and behavioral challenges might otherwise encounter environments that can deepen frustration, isolation, or disengagement from learning altogether. Instead, they find belonging, structure, and the chance to rebuild their confidence in a safe, compassionate environment.

Strawbridge is not just a school—it’s an academic lifeline and a place of possibility, where compassion and commitment meet potential.

Students start to believe they are worthy of love, safety, and success.



The Strawbridge Home for Boys is where it all began! What we now know as Strawbridge School was founded on 318 acres generously donated by George and Ella Albaugh more than a century ago—a place of care, education, and belonging for boys in need.

In October 2025, Everstand celebrated the dedication of a Historical Mile Marker near the original site of the Home—honoring the families, leaders, and community members who have carried the spirit of Strawbridge forward for generations.

Purpose in Action: Youth Gaining Ground

When you first meet Melissa A., you quickly notice her bright energy and determination. At just 20, she has grown through challenges many her age have never faced and carries herself with strength and resilience.

Melissa enjoys the grounding things in life—like organizing and cleaning her space. For her, tidying up isn't just about order; it creates a calm environment that helps her think clearly and focus. She also treasures music class and fondly remembers learning from Miss Cindy in Archaeology.

Though some may expect her to be reserved, Melissa is quick to share that she's actually outgoing and enjoys connecting with others. That openness has helped her build friendships and thrive at Everstand.

Melissa first arrived at Everstand in 2021 after her previous residential agency closed. While she was excited for a fresh start, adjusting to a new environment brought challenges. Over time, she found her place, supported by dedicated care teams and mentors. One memory she holds close is celebrating her "Sweet 16" with Everstand—a milestone she describes as unforgettable.

Looking toward the future, Melissa dreams of a career in cosmetology or dog grooming, passions that reflect her love for creativity, style, and caring for others. She especially enjoys expressing herself through fashion and receiving new clothes.

Melissa has also made remarkable personal progress. She has learned to manage her anger and irritability and now thrives in the Phoenix Program. One of her proudest accomplishments is gaining the ability to self-regulate—transforming from frequent outbursts to calm control.

Her growth was recognized with the MARFY Award, an honor that left her feeling both shy and grateful. "It meant so much to be seen for my school achievements and for overcoming challenges," she reflects.

Melissa credits her journey to those who stood by her side, especially her case manager Simone Mobley, and staff including Miss Paige Sanchez, Miss Michelle Citron, Miss Arcosta, Ms. Viva P., Mr. Wesley B., Mr. Darnell, Ms. Toni H., Ms. Ashley J., Ms. Jasmine, Ms. Valencia O., Ms. Marissa, and Mr. Thomas Turner.

If she could speak to her younger self, Melissa would offer simple advice: *"Be open to trusting people as you get to know them. You don't have to go through everything alone."*

Melissa's story is one of resilience, growth, and hope for the future—made possible with the support of her Everstand community.

The Faces of Generosity and the Power of Giving

Faith, family, and community form the heart of Tim and Kathy Wiles' work through The Brian and Patricia Giese Foundation. Guided by the belief that transformation begins with compassion and connection, the Wiles family has become an extraordinary partner to Everstand, advancing programs that restore hope for children and families across our communities.

"When we first learned about Everstand's programs, what stood out immediately was the emphasis on holistic care—supporting mental, emotional, and spiritual well-being together," shared Tim and Kathy. "That approach reflects our belief that healing and transformation happen when you see the whole person, not just their immediate need."

Through The Brian and Patricia Giese Foundation, the Wiles family has supported Everstand's Outpatient Mental Health Clinic, with special interest in initiatives like the **Parent Support Group** and **Therapeutic Drum Circle**. These programs bring families together in ways that transcend traditional therapy—creating safe spaces for emotional healing, relationship building, and community strength.

"The Parent Support Group and the Therapeutic Drum Circle are perfect examples," the Wiles' explained. "They meet families where they are, providing evidence-based care that restores relationships, builds confidence, and strengthens community bonds. That kind of work is what we're honored to invest in—because it creates ripples of hope that go beyond one program or one grant."

Their connection to Everstand is also deeply personal. Friends of the Wiles family experienced Everstand's trauma-informed therapy and parent coaching firsthand—an experience that left a lasting impression. "The growth in daily function, the renewed connection between parent and child — it was remarkable. That personal experience reaffirmed for us that Everstand isn't just doing good work, they're helping to change lives."

For the Wiles family, philanthropy is an act of faith in action. "Our foundation's mission is bold—we invest in faith-inspired ideas with the power to change the world. These programs give families the practical tools to rebuild, but also restore something deeper—hope. That's what we want to be part of."

Impact When it Matters Most

Every May, Keller Williams Realty honors the legacy of Mo Anderson through Red Day, a company-wide tradition of closing offices and dedicating time to community service. This year, the Keller Williams team partnered with Everstand, bringing more than just tools and time—they brought heart.

Although Adrienne Weldon stepped in unexpectedly to lead the effort after a colleague's health issues, she embraced the role wholeheartedly. "I'm grateful that Everstand was the organization we connected with," she reflected. "It was powerful for our agents to see firsthand the impact of the services and facilities you provide."

On the day of service, the team tackled projects across the campus—painting, organizing, landscaping, and even assisting with a youth relocation. Some agents rolled up their sleeves with chainsaws and tractors, while others cleared stumps or freshened up common spaces. "I still have photos of our agents out there, pulling stumps and painting," Adrienne said. "It was a gorgeous day, and everyone found a way to contribute."

For Adrienne, the most memorable moment was simply watching her team disperse from orientation to different areas of service. "Seeing them walk off in different directions, ready to give, and then coming back together at lunch with joy and stories—it just filled our souls," she shared. "When you serve, it fills your bucket as much as it fills somebody else's."

The day also offered perspective. As a mother of teenagers, Adrienne was struck by the challenges faced by Everstand youth. "It gave me a new awareness of the realities many kids experience, and deep gratitude for organizations like Everstand that step in to meet those needs."

Keller Williams' values—faith, family, and business—align seamlessly with Everstand's mission. "Fundraisers are meaningful, but being boots on the ground, side by side, speaks to our culture," Adrienne said.

Her message to future volunteers is simple: "You won't find a more hospitable or appreciative group. We felt so welcomed, and it was a blessing to serve. We look forward to continuing this partnership."

Careers with Impact and Purpose

People Who Move Us Forward

For more than a decade, Jalissa Gresham has dedicated her career to walking alongside young people as they navigate life’s hardest challenges. Joining Everstand (then Board of Child Care) in 2014 as a Youth Care Professional in West Virginia, Jalissa has become a steady presence for youth in Pennsylvania—offering structure and compassion in equal measure as the Assistant Program Director.

This past year, Jalissa and her team focused on expanding the continuum of care for youth preparing to age out of our programs. With the anticipated launch of a new Independent Living Program targeted for the end of the year, young people now have the opportunity to transition into stability while still receiving the support they need until age 21. “In Pennsylvania, there aren’t many options for youth 18 to 21,” she explains. “We wanted to be intentional about creating that space.”

The heart of Jalissa’s work is found in the everyday milestones she helps young people reach. She recalls the joy of watching one young mom not only attend her first prom but also walk across the stage to receive her diploma—an achievement she once thought impossible. “Seeing resiliency in real time is powerful,” Jalissa shares.

Her leadership style is rooted in presence. Jalissa makes it a point to step out of the office, spend time with youth, and ensure her staff understand the importance of their role. “It’s not babysitting. Our staff are shaping lives,” she emphasizes. Professional development for her team remains a top priority, as she knows empowered staff create stronger outcomes for youth.

Looking ahead, Jalissa is preparing to begin her doctorate in child welfare policy, with the hope of bringing light to disparities she has witnessed firsthand. “I love the work I do here and I want to affect change at a larger level,” she says.

Her vision for the future is simple yet profound: to ensure every young person has the safety, tools, and confidence they need to step into adulthood with hope.

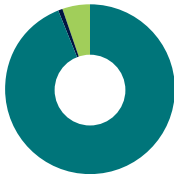
